The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with each agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. The Parish Council will announce at its **September 23, 2020 Regular Session** meeting the following vacancies:

RECREATION DISTRICT NO. 4: Two expiring terms (10-11-20).

AIRPORT COMMISSION: One expiring term (10-15-20).

COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT: Four expiring terms on 10-31-20. (One representing Commercial Fishing, one representing Flood Concerns, one representing Marine Navigation and one representing the Oil Industry).

HOUMA AREA CONVENTION AND VISITORS BUREAU: One expiring term on 12-31-20 representing a Civic Non-Profit Organization.

BAYOU CANE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT BOARD: One vacancy due to a resignation.

Interested individuals wishing to be appointed to a Recreation Board must be a resident of the Recreation District and be willing to attend regularly-scheduled meetings to discuss and take action on matters pertaining to recreational facilities and activities therein.
