The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking an individual to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agency in need of a member is a governmental organization that requires people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the November 8, 2006 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- **Recreation District No. 7 Board:** One expired term. The interested individual must be a resident of Ward 7 (Little Caillou) and interested in the operation of the recreation programs in the community.
- **Houma Area Visitors and Convention Bureau:** (Two expired terms) The interested individuals must be registered voters of the parish and interested in the promotion of this parish to outside visitors. The person must be nominated by an organization “interested in tourism”.
- **Downtown Development Corporation:** (Three expired terms). The interested individuals must be registered voters of the parish and interested in the revitalization and promotion of downtown Houma.
