

“NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC”

The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with each agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. The Parish Council will consider at its **November 18, 2020 Regular Session** meeting the following vacancies and appointments:

COTEAU FIRE DISTRICT: One unexpired term due to a resignation.

RECREATION DISTRICT NO. 3A: One expired term.

RECREATION DISTRICT NO. 5: Two expiring terms (11-27-20).

DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION: Four expiring terms (11-30-20). (One representing the Historical Society, one representing the Parish President, one representing the Council and one representing Arts and Humanities)

HOUMA-TERREBONNE REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION: Two appointments to be made: One expiring term on 11-30-20 (Council Appointment) and one unexpired term due to a resignation (Parish President representative).

TERREBONNE PARISH COMMUNICATION DISTRICT BOARD: Three appointments: One vacancy due to a resignation (representing the Public North Terrebonne – outside USD City Limits) and two expiring terms on 12-31-20 (one representing the Houma Fire Department and one representing the Sheriff’s Office).

TERREBONNE ARC: One vacancy due to a resignation (representing the Ministerial Alliance).

TERREBONNE PARISH TREE BOARD: One vacancy due to a resignation.

CHILDREN AND YOUTH SERVICES BOARD: Eight expiring terms (11-05-20) and (11-16-20). One representing each of the following: Louisiana Department of Social Services, Terrebonne Parish District Attorney’s Office, Office of Juvenile Justice, Gulf Coast Teaching and Family Services, DHH Office of Behavioral Health, Options for Independence, Houma Police Department and a Faith-Based Organization representative.

PORT COMMISSION: Three expiring terms on 12-31-20. (Council Appointments)

MUNICIPAL CIVIL SERVICE BOARD: One expiring term on 11-29-20. (Council Appointment)

PUBLIC FINANCE TRUST: Two expiring terms on 12-26-20. (Council Appointment)

Interested individuals wishing to be appointed to a Recreation Board must be a resident of the Recreation District and be willing to attend regularly-scheduled meetings to discuss and take action on matters pertaining to recreational facilities and activities therein.
