

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the April 14, 2004 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- **Bayou Blue Fire Protection District Board:** One vacant position. Individuals must be resident property-owners on the Terrebonne Parish side of the fire district and should be interested in the administration of the affairs of the fire district.

- **Fire Protection District No. 4 (Grand Caillou community):** One vacancy. Individuals must be resident property-owners of the district and should be interested in the administration of the affairs of the fire district.

- **Houma Zoning Commission:** One vacancy. Person should be ready to address zoning regulations in the Urban Services District. The person appointed must be a resident of the Urban Services District.
