- **Coastal Zone Management Advisory Council:** (two expired terms) Interested parties should be Terrebonne Parish residents and should have an interest and knowledge of the coastal issues.
- **Recreation District No. 1 Board:** (one expired term) Interested parties must residents of Recreation District No. 1 and should have an interest and knowledge of the recreation programs in the Gray/Schriever area).
- **Recreation District No. 10 Board:** (one expired term) ) Interested parties must residents of Recreation District No. 1 and should have an interest and knowledge of the recreation programs in the Bayou Dularge community.
- **Recreation District No. 5 Board:** (one expired term) Interested parties must residents of Recreation District No. 1 and should have an interest and knowledge of the recreation programs in the Bourg community.
- **Terrebonne Parish Communications District Board:** (one vacancy) Interested parties must be Terrebonne Parish residents north of the Intracoastal Canal and should have an interest or knowledge of the Enhanced 911 Emergency Response System.
