

## NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the February 13, 2008 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- **Coastal Zone Management Advisory Council:** (one expired term representing the real estate industry) interested parties should be Terrebonne Parish residents and should have an interest and knowledge of the coastal issues.
- **Bayou Cane Fire Protection District Board:** (one expired terms) Interested parties must be property-owning residents of the district and should be interested in the administration of local fire protection services.
- **Fire Protection District No. 8 Board:** (expired terms) interested parties must be property-owning residents of the district (Gibson, Donner & Chacahoula) and should be interested in the administration of local fire protection services.
- **Village East Fire Protection District Board:** (One expired term) Interested parties must be property-owning residents of the district and should be interested in the administration of local fire protection services.
- **South Central Human Services Authority Board:** (One vacancy) Interested parties must be interested in the newly formed state organization created to address mental health needs in the multi-parish district and should represent mental health services.
- **Houma Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service Board:** (Two vacancies) Interested parties must be residents of the City of Houma and somewhat familiar with civil services regulations.
- **Houma-Terrebonne Regional Planning Commission:** (One vacancy) Interested individuals should be residents of Terrebonne Parish and familiar with zoning and subdivision regulations. There are usually two meetings per month.

Anyone interested in serving on any of these boards should contact the Council Clerk's Office (985-873-6518) so that a Board Application Form may be obtained, completed, and returned to the Council Clerk's Office. A brief resume' should also be prepared and submitted.
