

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with each agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. *At at upcoming meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to each of the following entities:

Terrebonne Economic Development Authority (TEDA): One expired term, appointed by the Council (African American). Interested individuals must be a U.S. Citizen, qualified voter residing in Terrebonne Parish, and either a proprietor, partner, or officer of a business located within the boundaries of the authority. *(1//26/17)

Bayou Cane Fire Protection District Board: One expired term. Interested individuals applying for Fire District Boards must be resident property taxpayers of the Fire Districts they are applying for and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area. *(1/26/17)

Recreation District No. 8: One expiring term on 2/24/17. Interested individuals must be a resident of the recreation district and be willing to attend regularly-scheduled meetings to discuss and take action on matters pertaining to recreational facilities and activities therein. *(2/22/17)

Terrebonne Parish Tree Board Four expiring terms on 2/23/17. The Board’s responsibility is to study, investigate, counsel and develop and/or update annually, and administer a written plan for the care, preservation, pruning, planting, replanting, removal or disposition of trees and shrubs in parks, within public rights-of-way along streets and in other public areas. *(2/22/17)
