

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the December 2, 2009 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- Houma Area Convention and Visitors Bureau: (one vacancy) Interested individuals must be residents of the parish, nominated by a local civic or community organization involved somehow in tourism and interested in the promotion of Terrebonne Parish to outside visitors.
- Board of Adjustments: (one vacancy) Interested individuals must be residents of the City of Houma, knowledgeable of the zoning regulations and able to attend one afternoon meeting per month.
- Downtown Development Corporation: (one vacancy) Interested individuals must be citizens of Terrebonne Parish and interested in the future development of downtown Houma.
- Parish Cemetery Board: (two vacancies) Interested individuals must be citizens of Terrebonne Parish and have some knowledge of or interest in cemetery regulations.
- Boat Launch Advisory Committee: (one vacancy) Interested individuals must be citizens of Terrebonne Parish and have a desire to improve boat launch facilities in the parish.
