

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the November 14, 2007 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agency:

- **Village East Fire Protection District Board** (One vacancy): Interested citizens must be resident property owners of the Village East fire district and have interest in the administration of the fire protection services in the area.
- **Houma Board of Adjustments** – alternate member (One expired term): Interested citizens should be residents of the Urban Services District and should be somewhat knowledgeable or interested in zoning in the City of Houma.
- **Consolidated Waterworks District No. 1 Board** (District 7 Representative resigned): Interested applicants should be residents of Council District 7 (Grand Caillou, lower Bayou Dularge) and interested in the affairs of the waterworks district.
- **Coastal Zone Management Advisory Council:** (two expired terms) interested parties should be Terrebonne Parish residents and should have an interest and knowledge of the coastal issues.
- **Downtown Development Corporation:** (one vacancy) interested parties should be interested in the revitalization of downtown Houma.

Anyone interested in serving on any of these boards should contact the Council Clerk's Office (985-873-6518) so that a Board Application Form may be obtained, completed, and returned to the Council Clerk's Office. A brief resume' should also be prepared and submitted.
