2nd Annual Pastalaya on the Bayou Cook-off

Saturday, October 27, 2018 Houma Courthouse Square

Children's Water Safety Awareness is a non-profit organization based in Houma, LA that promotes water safety to all in our area, and provides support to those who have lost a loved one to a drowning incident. We are a campaign safety partner for "Pool Safely", a national public education campaign that works with partners around the country to reduce child drowning and entrapments in swimming pools and spas. We also directly represent four families who have lost children to drowning incidents, all under the age of three. In 2017 and 2018, we sponsored swimming lessons for over 100 local children ranging from ages 2 to 10 years old and CPR classes for over 35 adults. Each child and adults was able to receive professional swimming lessons free of charge. We want to continue our swimming lessons initiative, and are expanding our efforts to offering CPR lessons to adults, We now have our life jacket trade up program up and running.

- Event complete – clean up 4:00 pm
- Open Goode Street to traffic 5:00 pm

- After October 15, 2018, late registration fee is \$175 per team

Award Information

- Prizes given for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Peoples Choice
- Judges will sample each team's dish to determine 1st, 2nd, and 3rd
- For Peoples Choice:
 - Each wristband purchaser will receive 1 vote each
 - Votes will be collected by each team
 - It is the responsibility of the team to keep each vote
 - Additional votes can be purchased for \$1 each
 - Votes will be picked up and counted after moment of silence

Cook-off Rules

- Teams must register and pay before October 15, 2018. Any registration after October 15, 2018 will pay a late registration fee of \$175 per team.
- Double pots are permitted.
- Each team should prepare enough for 50 servings plus judges' servings.
- Any style of pasta is allowed – **NO RICE!!!**
- Any combination of meat is allowed. **NO SEAFOOD OR WILD GAME.**
- All meat must be boneless, and can be seasoned ahead of time.
- There will be no pre-cooking of ingredients.
- All cooking will take place on Goode St. between Main St. and School St.
- Teams must provide all cooking and cleaning supplies, serving utensils, tents, tables, chairs, fire extinguishers, etc. just as if you were tailgating. Teams are responsible for cleaning their cooking / serving areas.
- Bowls, Spoons, and Napkins will be provided.
- Teams will be allowed to enter with a vehicle from Belanger St. to set up. All vehicles must be removed before 8:30 am.
- Barricades will remain in place with no vehicle traffic until 5:00 pm.
- Portable radios will be allowed in cooking area before the live music begins. No profanity allowed.
- Water and soft drinks will be available for purchase on site. **Reminder – no glass bottles allowed.**
- Patrons without wristbands should not be served.
- In order for latecomers to have samples, please do not package food in bags prior to 2:30 pm. If you wish to clean up early, package your food in disposable aluminum pans (provided by you). Taking bags or containers of food from the event site before the event ends is strongly discouraged.
