

ATTENTION LOW-INCOME HOMEOWNERS

Do you have a home health or safety hazard that needs to be corrected?

The Terrebonne Parish Homeowner Health and Safety Hazard Repair Program will be taking applications December 4 – 6, 2018 at the TPCG Department of Housing and Human Services office located at 809 Barrow Street (Town Hall Building) from 8:30am to 4:00pm. Applicants must be low-income and own at least 50% of the home/property and reside in the home as their principal residence. All Terrebonne Parish low-income homeowners may apply; however preference will be given to applicants that live in rural areas (outside the city limits) and applicants that meet the definition of very-low income.

Health and safety hazards are defined as a situation or condition that is detrimental to or a threat to life, health or safety, such as:

- Sewer line breaks
- Water line breaks
- Gas line breaks
- Inoperable or unsafe water heater
- Electrical system failures
- Roof leaks
- Unstable, sagging or rotten subflooring
- Need for handicap accessibility ramp or modifications (requires documentation of need from physician)

Applicants must provide copies of the following documents at the time of application:

Proof of ownership (deed/title showing 100% interest)

Proof of Homestead Exemption

Current Louisiana drivers license or picture ID for all adult household members

Social Security cards for all household members

Last 2 months of bank statements

Proof of income for all adult household members over 17 years of age

Social security, survivor's benefits, disability, retirement, etc. - most recent annual statement from provider

Earned income - employed persons must provide check stubs for the last 2 months of employment

Child Support - judgment and/or printout from child support enforcement

Alimony - judgment

Unemployment or Worker's Compensation – statements or receipts for last 2 months

All other income – statements or receipts for last 2 months

No income - signed Certification of Zero Income form (adults over 17 years of age only) Forms can be picked from receptionist desk Monday through Friday from 8am -4pm prior to application dates.

Completed applications that include copies of the required items listed above will be date and time stamped upon submission. Eligible applicants will be served on a first-come first-served basis after preferences have been applied.

Copies will not be made at the TPCG office. Copies can be made at the Terrebonne Parish Library for a fee of 10 cents per page.



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
