Terrebonne Parish Hazard Mitigation Plan Update 2020
Public Meeting

The Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government is updating the parish's Hazard Mitigation Plan. The purpose of the plan update is to identify and pursue preventative measures that will reduce future damages from natural hazards. The plan is required by FEMA to be updated every five years. This is the second public meeting in the evening to review the input in the previous six meetings.

This second evening meeting will be held at Bayou Terrebonne Waterlife Museum December 19th from 5:30-7:30 for anyone interested in participating. We will review the new maps, the goals and objectives, the repetitive loss strategy, the mitigation strategy, and prioritize the possible activities to reduce risk. This is the last step in the process prior to drafting the action plan.

The public is encouraged to attend this meeting and provide input and perspective to the planning process.
