

David Greely, is one of the premier fiddlers in Cajun music, a four-time Grammy nominee, and a veteran of the Louisiana dance hall scene and concert and festival performances worldwide. He helped found the popular group Steve Riley and the Mamou Playboys, with whom he played and recorded for 23 years. David's apprenticeship to master fiddler Dewey Balfa, his archival research and his obsession with history allow him to trace the story of Cajun and Creole music through the centuries until today.

South Louisiana is a rich blend of flavors from France, Canada, Africa, Ireland, England, Germany and many other places. Of Irish/Cajun ancestry, born and raised in South Louisiana, David embraces all of these influences into an exciting funky instrumental technique that sounds like much more than one fiddle.
