#### **Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government Closely Monitoring Tropical Storm Cindy**

**Houma (June 21, 2017)** – Terrebonne Parish President Gordon Dove has declared a state of emergency for Terrebonne Parish due to the developing threat Tropical Storm Cindy. The state of emergency will allow the parish government to take all necessary measures to ensure the safety, health and welfare needs of the citizens and property of Terrebonne Parish.

The Terrebonne Parish Public Works Division has placed sand and sandbags at the following locations: Bobtown Volunteer Fire Department, Adult Softball Complex on Airbase, Cannata's West, Mechanicville Gym, Knights of Columbus Hall in Pointe-aux-Chenes, Civic Center, Devon Keller Memorial Center, Upper Dularge Fire Station, St. Ann Church in Bourg, Bayou Black Fire Station, Ward 7 in Chauvin, Gibson East Fire Department, and Gibson Fire Department. Also, the Public Works North Campus located at 206 Government St., Gray, La will be open to public from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM - Mondays thru Fridays only.

The Terrebonne Parish Levee District has closed all floodgates.

All Terrebonne Parish Government Offices remain open.
