Beginning on October 11th you will be able to visit our office, located in the Government Tower Building, or visit our website tpassessor.org to use the "Disaster Relief" program to upload documentation and photos.

- 1. Itemized Insurance Claim forms**
- 2. Photos**
- 3. FEMA Claim form**
- 4. Receipts for any repair to the structure and invoices from contractors if used for repair.**
